It will be very helpful if each student has the following school supplies for the first day of school:

ASSIGNMENT BOOK/HOMEWORK FOLDER: Both items will be available in our classrooms on the first day of school, no charge, these will be provided.

3 Two Pocket folders (different colors)

2 ONE-SUBJECT NOTEBOOKs: (For writing and math, Please – no Trapper Keepers or large binders. We have tables and do not have places to store these items.)

2 small composition notebooks: (for reading & math journals)

2 three-ring binders (1 1/2"): (to be used as subject area portfolios, ELA & Math)

PENCILS: Students will need <u>lots</u> of pencils.

OPTIONAL: Scissors, crayons, markers, or colored pencils (small boxes), glue stick

Please be mindful of the fact that students keep all materials with them or in their backpack. We do not have desks, we have tables. Also, students will be moving throughout the day from class to class, so transporting materials needs to be easy for them. Thank you!
